1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this contest.
2. ENTIRE DISPLAY MAY BE NO LARGER THAN 10" X 10" AND NO HIGHER THAN 9." Any displays that are larger will not be allowed.
3. 4-H exhibitors 5 to 7 years old may enter, but they will be for display only and not be judged for competition.
4. This is a contest for individuals only – no teams, Clubs or Chapters may enter.
5. This is a fee-based contest. See above.
6. Due to space requirements there is a limit of 210 exhibits. Entries will be stamped with the date and time they are received. Once we reach 210, entries will not be accepted and the exhibitor's 4-H Leader or FFA Advisor will be notified.
7. Exhibits must be returned for competition on the day and time listed above. It may be decorated in any style that the exhibitor wishes, i.e. paint, cloth, paper, jewelry, feathers, etc. The exhibitor's name must be clearly printed on the bottom of the exhibit.
8. All exhibits must be completed by the exhibitor.
9. Only one (1) exhibit per exhibitor.
10. No offensive or obscene material will be allowed.
11. Decisions of Judging Committee will be final.
12. Early pick-up of exhibits is not allowed. It is understood that the exhibits will remain on display for the entire Fair.
13. The Southeastern Youth Fair will assume no responsibility or liability for the damage or loss of articles exhibited. Supervision will be provided during Fair hours.
14. Exhibits and awards not picked up on the above day will be forfeit and become the property of the SEYF.

AWARDS

15. The Show Coordinator reserves the right to withhold awards if there is not sufficient competition or, if in the opinion of the judges, the quality of work does not merit an award.
16. Premiums may be awarded after all sponsorship has been collected and all expenses have been paid on individual shows & events.

1st through 3rd places – Junior, Intermediate & Senior Divisions

All exhibitors will receive a participation award.
