Fashion Revue is a show that will develop the skills necessary to plan, select, or construct clothing for different occasions, and enhance their ability to determine which accessories are suitable and becoming. Marion County 4-H and FFA Participants can build self-confidence and poise through developing and understanding of “self” through the categories listed below.

1. The SEYF General Rule & Regulations apply to this show.
2. Participants may only enter one category.
3. Scoring and winners in each category and age division will be selected on three parts:
 - a. Garment evaluation
 - b. Modeling and presentation
 - c. Skill-a-thon performance
4. Score cards, procedures and training/study kits are available through Marion County 4-H Extension Office.

CATEGORIES

- Traditional
- Purchased
- Recycled
- Wearable Art-Embellished
- Needle Arts

Traditional: This category is for sewn garments. The intention is to show off the sewing skills of the participant. One garment must be constructed, it is not necessary to construct the whole outfit.

Purchased: This category focuses on the member’s ability to have positive consumer skills. Garment must have been purchased within the current 4-H year (does not include accessories). Receipts are required for everything listed as purchased.

Recycled: The member will design and sew a wearable garment from previously used materials. The completed garment must be different from the original, with at least a 50% change. Before and after photos are required, along with receipts from current year.

Wearable Art-Embellished: The member will decorate a garment using arts and crafts techniques. Any part of the outfit can be embellished, although it is required that the main garment is decorated (accessories are not a main garment). Before and after photos are required, along with receipts from current year.

Needle Arts: Member will demonstrate their ability to knit, crochet or weave a garment and coordinate an outfit around that garment. Note this is a garment not an accessory (i.e. Scarves, hats, belts); accessories can be a part of outfit, but not the main entry. Receipts from current year are required.
