1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. A teacher, leader, or parent is responsible for ensuring exhibits were produced by the exhibitor between March 2011 and February 2012.
3. Early pick-up of exhibits is not allowed. It is understood that all exhibits will remain on display for the entire Fair.
4. Exhibits and awards not picked up on the designated day and time will be forfeited and be returned to the SEYF.
5. The Southeastern Youth Fair will assume no responsibility or liability for the damage or loss of articles exhibited. Supervision will be provided during Fair hours.

CLASSES

6. Based on the number of entries the Show Coordinator may create or combine classes.
7. Each class is divided into Junior, Intermediate and Senior divisions.
8. All items must fit in one of the categories listed. No items will be allowed for display only.
9. Exhibitors may enter only one item in each of the categories.
10. **Classes I items must be framed with hardware attached.**
11. **Class II items must be 8" x 10" with a 2" white matte border. NO FRAMED PHOTOS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
12. **Class III items must indicate the ratio of the scale.**
13. Class VII & VIII may not be needlework items.
