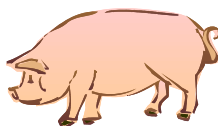

WHO CAN BID?

Any business, individual, community club or group.

HOW DO I REGISTER AND GET A NUMBER?

Call the Youth Fair office at 352-629-1255 or At the night of the sale at the registration table. Registration PRIOR to the night of the sale is preferred.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE BIDDER NUMBER?

Hold your number up when bidding. Hold it up once you have bought an animal, this will give the auctioneer your name to announce.

Once committed to the bid you are responsible for the purchase of that animal.

All animals are sold to the highest bidder.

Payment is expected the night of the Sale unless prior arrangements are made with the Youth Fair Office. The FFA/4-H member will be paid upon receipt of collected funds.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I PURCHASE THE ANIMAL?

Stay in your seat, a Youth Fair Ambassador will come to you with the Buyer's Agreement for you to fill in the Buyer's name, address, telephone number, and signature.

At this time, you have the following two choices as to what to do with the animal:

RESALE OR CUSTOM PROCESING?

1] RESALE

The animal goes to the "resale buyer" and you DO NOT GET THE MEAT. A resale price is announced at the beginning of the sale. You pay the amount of your bid *less* the resale price.

Example: You bid \$2.00/lb, the resale price is \$.50/lb, you pay \$1.50/lb.

2] CUSTOM PROCESSING

YOU MAKE ARRANGEMENTS WITH A CUSTOM PROCESSOR PRIOR TO THE SALE AND KEEP THE MEAT.

Please see the reverse side of this brochure for a list of USDA approved plants within the North Central Florida area who have agreed to accept and process animals from our Fair.
