This is an exhibit for 5 – 7 year old 4-H members.

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. All exhibitors must be 5 to 7 years old as of September 1, 2011.
3. Exhibitors may enter only one (1) item in a class; Exhibitor may enter a TOTAL of three (3) projects. (A plant would count as one project in the total of three (3)).
4. All entries must have been completed by the exhibitor between March 2011 and February 2012. A teacher, leader, or parent is responsible for ensuring exhibits were student produced during this time period.
5. All articles must be cleaned, pressed and displayed on appropriate hardware.
6. Early pick-up of exhibits will not be allowed. All exhibits remain on display for the entire Fair.
7. Exhibits not picked up on the day and time listed above will be forfeited and become the property of the SEYF.
8. The Fair does not assume responsibility for lost or stolen articles. Supervision of exhibits will be provided during hours the exhibits are open to the public.
